Dear Parents/ Carers/ Members of the School Community,

The weeks are flying by, especially when we have had the short Bank Holiday week, and we are getting prepared for a wide range of assessments that need to be carried out.

Next week, Year 6 will be completing their SATS covering the areas of Maths, Reading and Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation. This is the culmination of the work that has been achieved over the past 7 years at primary school and is used by secondary schools to forecast potential GCSE grades. Please ensure that your child is well prepared for the tests by ensuring they get a good night's sleep and breakfast in the morning. The tests will run each morning (Monday – Thursday.)

After Half Term, Year 1 pupils, and some Year 2 pupils, will be sitting the Phonics Screening Check, which is a check to see how well children know the initial sounds they need to begin their lifelong reading journey. These results will be shared with you in the end of year reports.

Lastly, Year 4 pupils will be undertaking the MTC (Multiplication Tables Check) during June. Again, this is a check that all Year 4 children are required to complete to make sure that times table knowledge is at the expected level.

The SATS, Phonics Screening and Multiplication Check, are part of the tests that the government expect all schools to administer.

This week we have had a number of visits into school from Delta Academy Trust and they have begun to look in detail at key aspects of each school that is currently part of Coast and Vale. Alongside this, you may have noticed a wide range of workman on site, who are bringing the school up to speed with faster Wi-Fi, which will be great.
